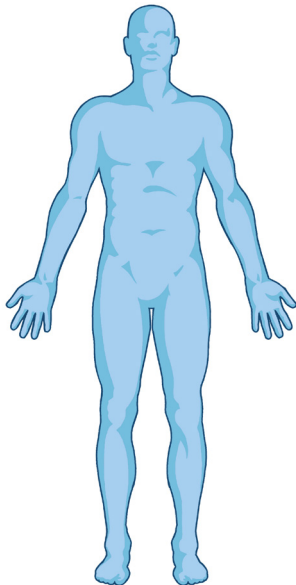
Outpatient Surgical Centers

What is an Outpatient Surgical Center?

Surgical Centers are medical facilities dedicated to specific types of surgeries – usually procedures that don't require an overnight stay.

What common services can be performed at a Surgical Center?

How do charges differ from the hospital and a surgical center?

Common Procedure	Cash Hospital Price	Cash Surgical Center Price
Total Knee Replacement	\$29,000 - \$45,000	\$20,000 - \$25,000
Carpal Tunnel Surgery	\$1,500 - \$3,000	\$950 - \$1,000
ACL Repair	\$12,000 - \$16,000	\$4,500 - \$8,000
Shoulder Rotator Cuff Repair	\$12,000 - \$15,000	\$2,600 - \$6,500

Cash prices above do not include insurance discounts. These are estimates only.

What is my Regence Benefit for Surgical Centers?

HSA Plan – you pay 5% or remaining charges AFTER you've paid your deductible until you reach your out of pocket maximum at a surgery center.
